# Senno Rikyu – 千利休

Sen no Rikyu is famous as one of the creators of the tea ceremony, and we study his culture and history when we are in high school or middle school.

Sen no Rikyu, who was born in Osaka Sakai City 500 years ago, started the tea ceremony at the age of 17. Little by little, he created his own original tea ceremony culture and method, which took about 40 years to perfect.

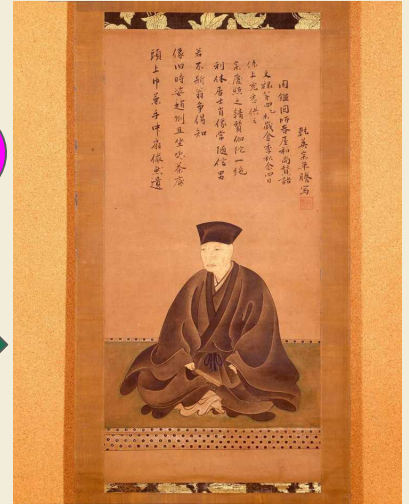


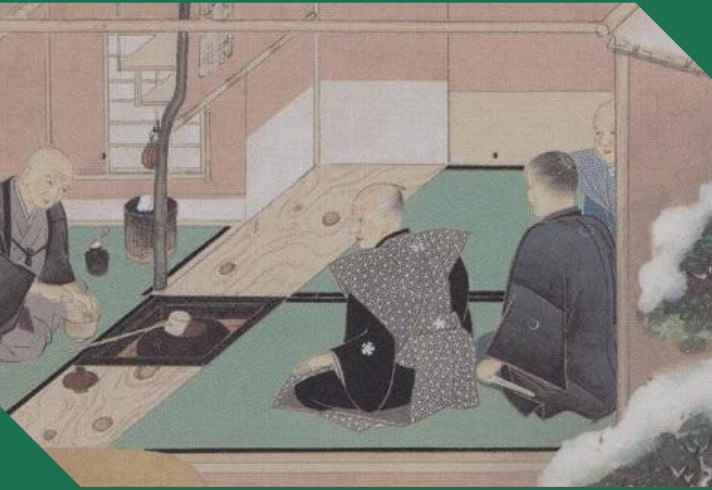

Tea Ceremony important spirit

和 敬 清 寂  
Wa-kei-Sei-Jaku

“Wa” means that the host and the guest **open their hearts** to each other.

“Kei” means to **respect each other**.

“Sei” means **pure**. It means to be pure in mind as well as in sight.

“Jaku” means **calm and unmoved at all times** .





# Wabi-Sabi 侘び寂び

Wabi means “Something simple” and in tea ceremony, it means “**Beauty from simplicity** .”

Sabi means **the beauty from s erenity that comes with age .**

Antiques would be an obvious example.

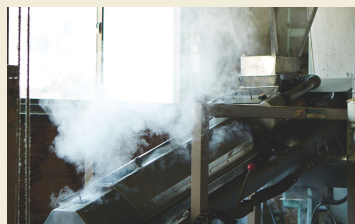

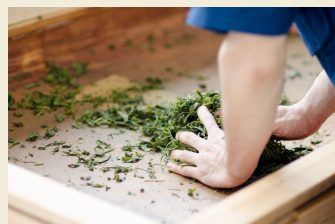

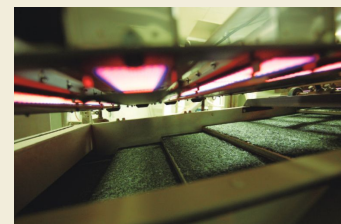
